Financials

For a returning cheerleader who already has the required backpack and the previous season's white poms the total should be for the entire season \$805.55. For a cheerleader brand new to the program, the cost should be \$940.55. We did not include cheer shoes in this cost as many already have cheer shoes and some would prefer to purchase these on their own. The requirement is that they MUST be white cheer shoes. Not just a white sneaker but a shoe specific for cheer. These fees will be broken into 3 payments. The first payment, which is half of your overall balance, will be due at the uniform fitting on April 23. The second payment, half of your remaining balance, will be due at the June or July cheer clinic, whichever you choose for your daughter to participate in. The final payment will be due at the choreography camp at the end of July. Your balance must be paid in full in order for your daughter to receive her uniform and items for the season. If you wish to pay in full at the uniform fitting, please feel free to do so. We break it up into payments in order to make it easier for you. Payments can be made by cash, check, or credit card but credit card payments will incur a fee 3%
